### SCRATCH POLICY

Junior Varsity and Varsity head coaches will be permitted to scratch a maximum of five (5) officials from the roster each season. Scratched officials shall not be assigned to that school's games in that particular sport during the regular season. In the interest of affording scratched officials the opportunity for self-improvement, coach shall state reason(s), in writing, for scratching any official. Scratches from the previous season shall apply to the first assignment period of the succeeding season, as well.

Automatic Scratches: Officials will not be assigned to a school's game if they: (1) work at that school or feeder pattern school, (2) have member of their immediate family attending the school, (3) have a relative working at the school, (4) are a graduate of (or attended) the school within the last fifteen (15) years, (5) assist with coaching teams which provide athletes for that school, (6) are close social friends with coaches of that school. It is the responsibility of the official to notify the Commissioner of the sport of any school whose games he/she should not officiate due to the reasons stated in this section.

### Explanation of check boxes:

- Appearance:** Officials are expected to be neatly dressed in appropriate uniform.
- Mechanics:** Officials are expected to use proper mechanics in their signals and relative positioning on the court.
- Knowledge of Rules:** Officials are expected to enforce the rules fairly and impartially. They may not allow themselves to be influenced by coaches, players, or spectators.
- Demeanor:** Officials are expected to respect their partner(s), coaches, players, and spectators and to conduct themselves in a manner which commands respect.
- Game Management:** Officials must maintain adequate control over the game to prevent abuses of the rules of conduct by coaches or players.
